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INTERPRETATION

Supine Burial, orientated W-E (head to west). Arms & legs extended - straight. Some evidence of disturbance to burial around torso, but otherwise fairly well preserved. Burial is just laid horizontally - the feet are slightly elevated, & the torso of the burial is slightly slumped.

* Upon initial examination the feet only were observed & despite repeated cleaning no grave cut could be identified - leading to belief that the burial was heavily truncated. However, following lifting of the feet leg bones were observed in situ & remainder of skeleton exposed.
