OBSERVATIONS
Done on a hot Wednesday. Probably includes rubble from a collapse both west + east. Lots of black glass + roof tiles. Not a continuous rectangle shape.

DESCRIPTION
Position within sector: located immediately east of rooms 1 & 3
Shape: long rectangular with irregular edges

Surface (slope direction; visible inclusions): Slope is very slight facing south. Inclusions include pottery, tufo and travertine

Observations about inclusions (Clusters? Deposition slope): Inclusion clusters are dense and range from medium to large in size.

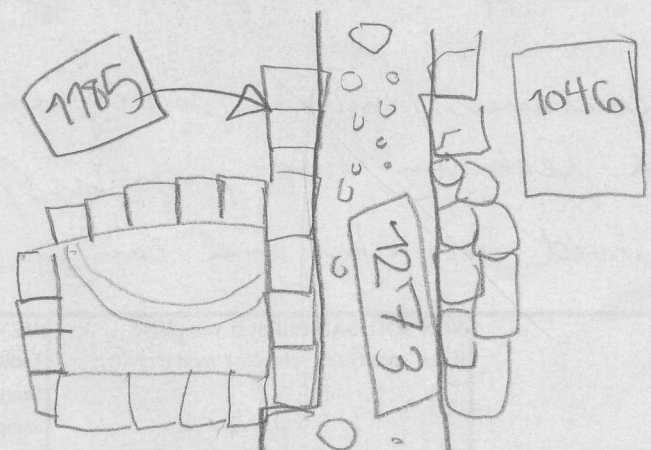

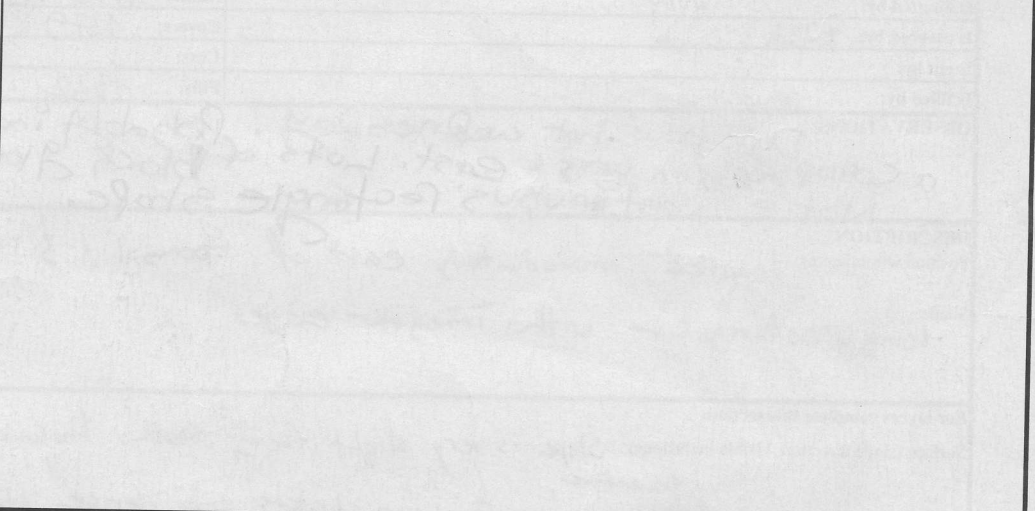
