


**INTERPRETATION**

CERAMIC BOWL INTENTIONALLY DEPOSITED AS A GRAVE GOOD. THIS BOWL WAS PROBABLY DEPOSITED WITHIN THE BURIAL AT A POINT AFTER THE DEPOSITION OF THE BODY BECAUSE OF THE PRESENCE OF OSSEOUS MATERIAL BENEATH IT. IT MAY HAVE BEEN DEPOSITED IN TEMPORAL ASSOCIATION WITH THE OTHER 2 VESSELS IN THE PRIMARY DEPOSITION, (SUITS 176). IF MATERIAL WAS DEPOSITED WITHIN THE BOWL DURING THE INITIAL DEPOSITION, RESIDUE OF SUCH MATERIAL MAY BE FOUND IN THE MACRO/MICRO BOTANICAL ANALYSIS OF THE SEDIMENT.
