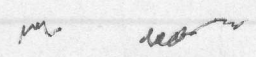

Partially preserved cocciopesto floor comprising polychrome surface - red, white, yellow, grey/green. Beneath a preparation comprising brown tufo fragments similar to 2202 + 2213 + 2253

**INTERPRETATION**

floor of room 5, largely preserved but missing in places due to erosion and truncation. Two large cuts exist, 2236, 2238, that are responsible for destruction of floor. SU 2231, 2232 are both plaster ledges which sit on top of floor (see sketch). Nothing of significance (cocciopesto)

So context was preserved sitting on the floor ← I think this means: no finds related to occupation of house were recovered.
