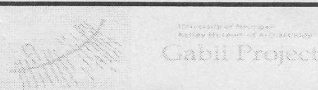

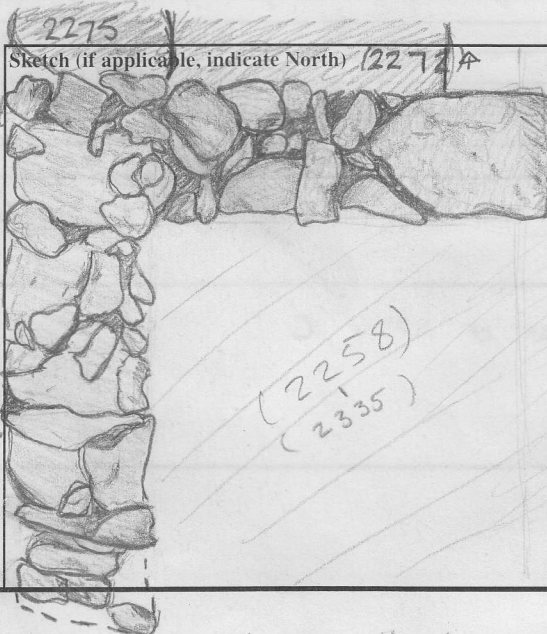

Description:

Wall foundation in irregular basalt. Variated sizes from large to small all unworked except for the most eastern block of the E-W arm which is cut to have one square edge. the N-S arm is longer than the E-w and is truncated from its original length by construction cut 2285. Some GREY TUFO INTERMIXED W/ BASALT.



**INTERPRETATION**

- wall foundation forming a corner. eastern limit of E-W arm suggests intentional cut, perhaps as threshold, TOGETHER W/ THE WESTERN LIMIT OF 2274.
- truncated at southern limit of N-S wall by construction cut 2285 for wall 2259
- abutted by floor 2272 TO THE NORTH.

TOGETHER WITH WALLS 2274 AND 2276, THIS WALL DELIMITED A ROOM THAT SEEMS TO HAVE OPENED OFF OF THE SOUTHERN SIDE OF THE ATRIUM (ROOM C7). THE STRATIGRAPHIC RELATIONSHIP OF THIS WALL AND THE REMAINS OF THE GRAY TUFO WALL TO THE NORTH IS UNCERTAIN: THEY ARE ON SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT ALIGNMENTS, BUT MUST AT LEAST BELONG TO THE SAME PHASE, BASED ON THE FACT THAT COCCIOPESTO FLOOR 2272 ABUTS THEM BOTH.
