

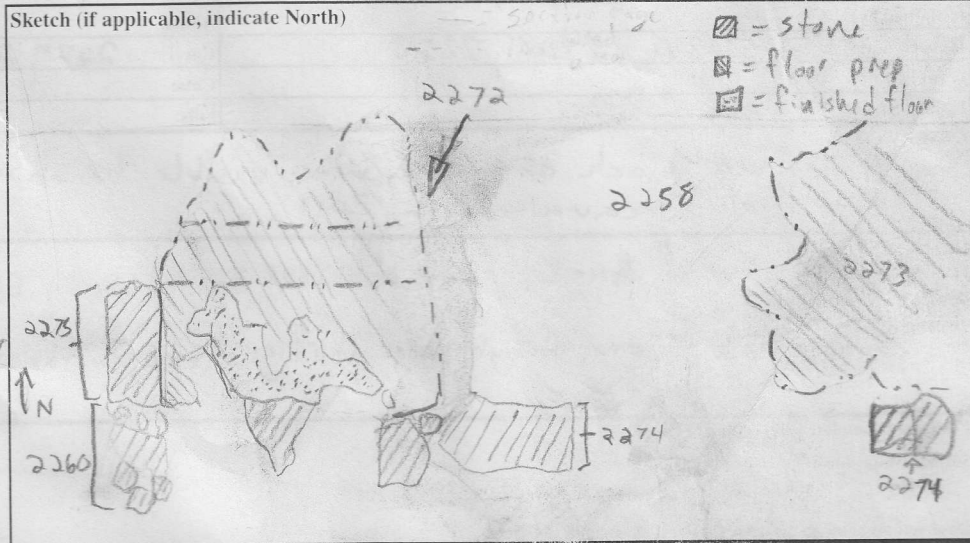

Description: Remnants of *coccio pesto* floor preparation with a small area of finished floor. Abuts 2274 to the South, and 2275 to the West. Roughly in the center is a darker area running E-W, with fewer and smaller tufo preparation pieces. Cut to the east in a nearly straight line, oriented N-SE; this cut is stopped by SU 2274. Another deep gouge, running NW-SE, is present in the SW of the floor prep.

INTERPRETATION

Given that it neatly abuts 2274 and 2275, this floor surface can be presumed to postdate both. Its level, location, and construction seem to indicate a oretime contiguity with 2273. The differing cut-types and levels of preservation, however, made this assignment slightly tenuous. The processes that damaged or removed the floor surfaces are unclear pending further excavation, as are those which cut through the floor altogether.
