

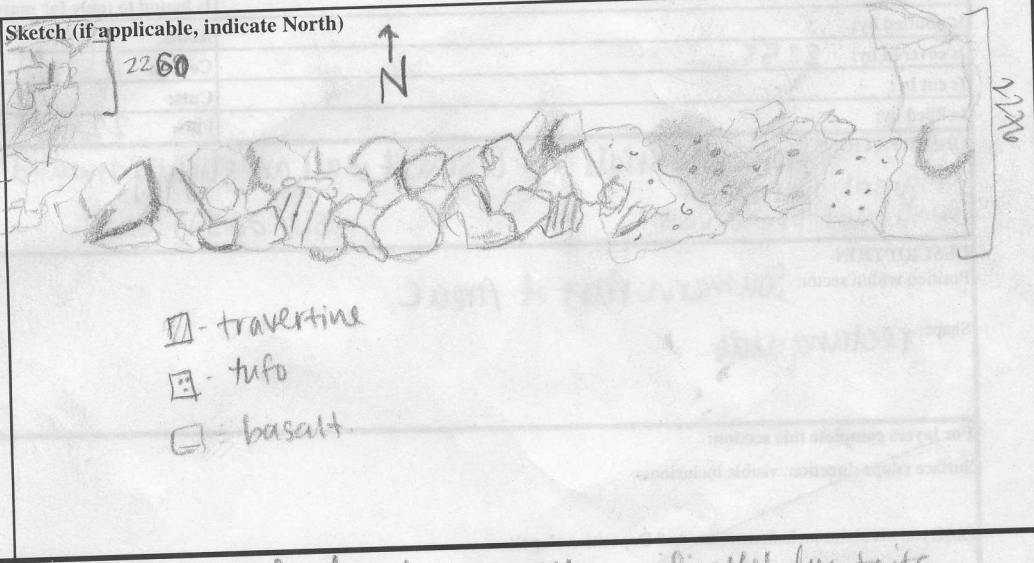

Description: *The base of a wall foundation*

*The rocks are irregularly shaped with different mediums: tufo, travertine, basalt. The far east blocks are degraded and eroded. The wall doesn't have a strict or straight shape, unlike SU 2259. The east side of the wall is not with a perpendicular line of large basalt blocks.*



**INTERPRETATION** *It is thought that this is the base of a foundation wall, specifically due to its alignment with 2051/2052/2053/2071. The interpretation of this wall is associated with SU 2259 (see SU sheets). At this point it seems to be a retaining wall, possible first century B.C. Originally documented as a single wall (2259) but because of the difference in rock orientation and size <sup>now</sup> thought to be a separate wall. The irregular north & south wall sides further evidences this idea. During the removal of the wall, inclusions of pottery; bone were found*
