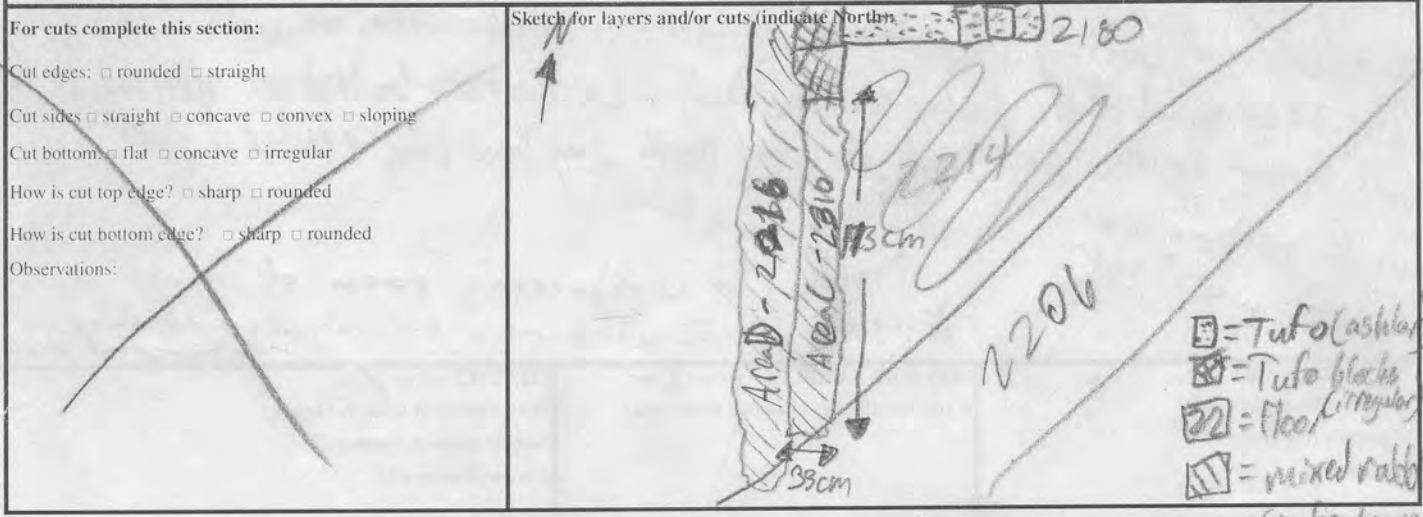

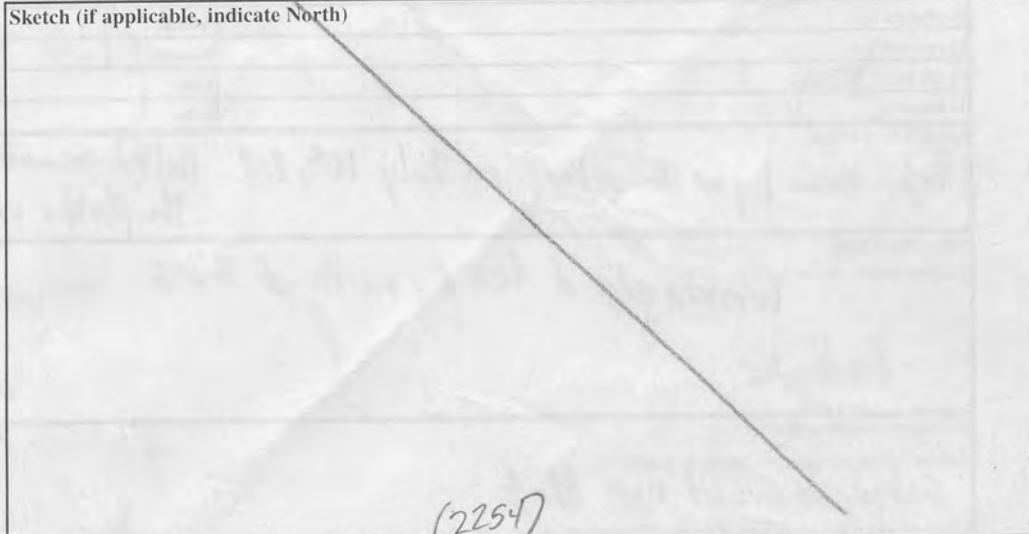

INTERPRETATION

Rubble fill from a robbing trench that continues south^v of the drainage trench (2206). Probably post dates the rubble wall (2216) on its western side and when robbed, the rubble wall partially collapsed into the trench. Similar situation with 2223 collapsing into 2254 south of the drainage trench (2206). Excavation halted on 7/19/2014 as there was danger to the plaster wall. Original depth may have been reached in places.
