


INTERPRETATION

The field directors identified a cut (3326) and fill (3319) along the western edge of wall 3096 in room 2, which appeared to "continue" beneath the wall. They considered the vertical orientation of a piece of travertine as indication of a posthole related to the Iron Age occupation of the site, but I was unable to observe a distinction b/w the fill and surrounding soil. I do not think this was a fill, just some scattered stones
