


INTERPRETATION

A BLOCK THAT FORMED PART OF ASHLAR WALL 5006, WHICH BECAME PARTLY DISLODGED - EITHER BY NATURAL EROSION OR BY HUMAN DUMPING ACTIVITY - AFTER THE WALL HAD ALREADY BEGUN TO COLLAPSE AND HAD LOST SEVERAL BLOCKS FROM ITS UPPER COURSES.
